

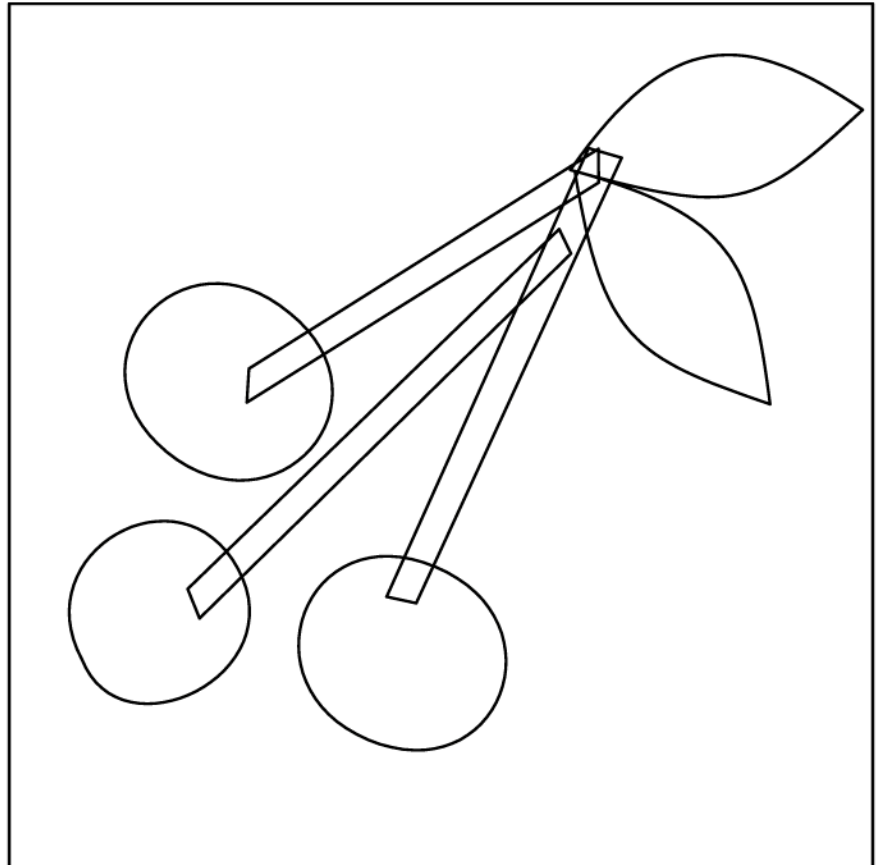
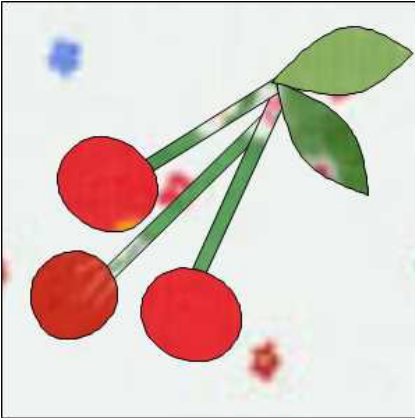
Cherries

Cherries

Enlarge the pattern 200% to make a 9" finished block.

Cut a 10" square of fabric for the background.

Find some bright red fabric for the cherries and shades of green for the leaves and stems.

Using the method of your choice, appliqué the various pieces in place. Or, get creative and have some fun. Wouldn't yo-yo's make great cherries? How about some ric-rac for the stems?

Once everything is in place, trim the block to 9½" square.
