Butterfly

To make this block, you will make a 7" paper-pieced block and then add pieces to the side to make a 9" finished block.

1. Paper piece the butterfly:

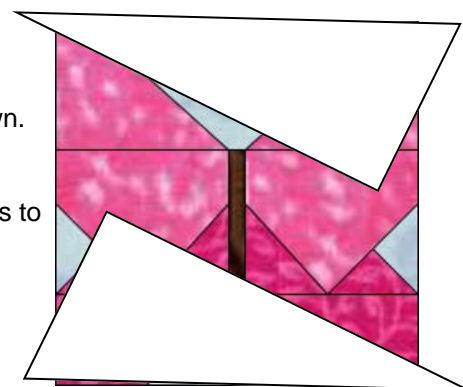
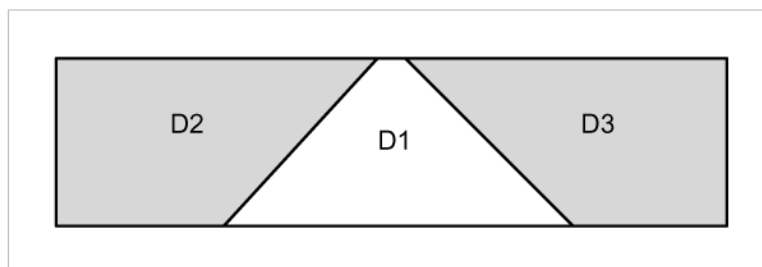
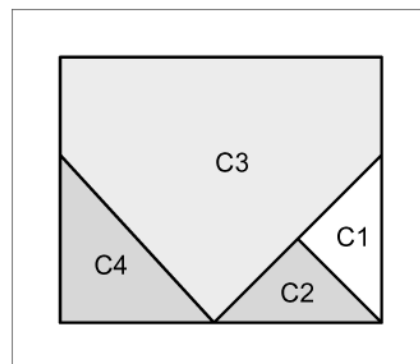
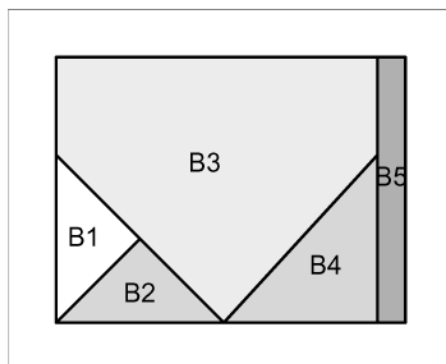
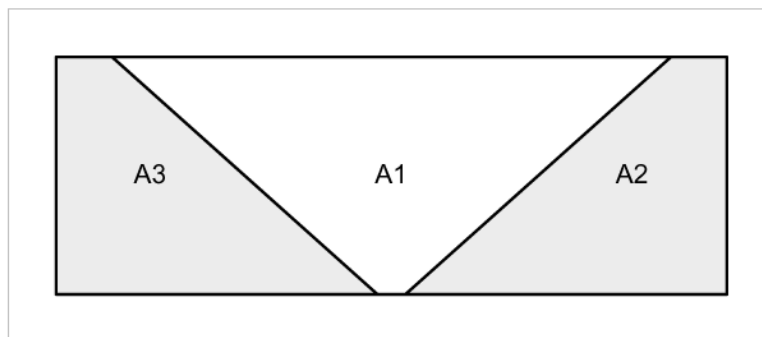
Begin by enlarging the pattern at right 200% to make a 7" finished block.

The block is assembled using foundation paper piecing techniques. Sew each section and then join the sections to make the butterfly block.

2. Skew the block:

- Cut two 4" x 8" rectangles of sky fabric. Cut each in half diagonally to make four triangles.
- Sew one triangle to the top and one to the bottom of the butterfly block as shown. Press to the sky.
- In the same manner, add the other two triangles to the sides of the block. Press to sky.

3. Embellish as desired.
