

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

If it is necessary to wash this quilt, please wash it in COLD water and use a delicate laundry detergent such as Orvus Paste, Ivory, Palmolive or Dove. Set the machine on delicate/gentle cycle or use a front-loading machine. Wash the quilt by itself with lots of water to minimize stress. Add 1 1/2 cups of white vinegar to the wash water to keep the colors bright and fresh. Rinse in cold water.

Lay the quilt flat to dry. NEVER line dry and DO NOT WRING. If you can't lay it flat, dry the quilt by itself in a dryer. Dry on low heat for the first few minutes and finish by air drying.

DISPLAY/STORAGE

A hanging sleeve has been installed on the back of the quilt so that it may be easily hung and enjoyed. Just insert a dowel or rod through the sleeve and hang it away from direct sunlight.

To store the quilt, wrap it in cotton (old pillow cases work well) and roll it very gently, like a sleeping bag , or fold it loosely to prevent creases. Stuff the creases with acid-free tissue. Every few months, unwrap the quilt and let it air for 2 to 3 hours. Then refold in a different shape to minimize creasing. Do NOT store the quilt in plastic, cardboard boxes or trunks.
